Renowned Clinical Programs

The Heart & Vascular Institute Of New Jersey

Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is a leader in cardiac care. Our Cardiac Surgery program consistently has the best outcomes in New Jersey. Our Medical Center was among the top three hospitals in the country for 30-day heart attack patient survival rate, according to a 2008 study by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The same data found that patients had a better chance of surviving a heart attack at Englewood Hospital than at any other hospital in New Jersey.



Primary Stroke Center

Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is part of a group of fewer than 150 hospitals nationwide designated by The Joint Commission as a Primary Stroke Center. In 2009, the Medical Center received approval as a Primary Stroke Center by the New Jersey Department of Health & Senior Services.

The Dizzy Gillespie Cancer Institute

Since its founding in 1993, the Dizzy Gillespie Cancer Institute at Englewood Hospital and Medical Center has grown into a world-renowned oncology center that is recognized as a model for cancer diagnosis and management. Our brand new Infusion Center opened for operation in the fall of 2008.

The Leslie Simon Breast Care and Cytodiagnosis Center



Designated by Congress in 1994 as a national model for breast cancer diagnosis and management, the Center is one of the only all-digital mammography centers in New Jersey and the only one in the state with an Aurora Dedicated Breast MRI System.

Orthopedic Institute and Joint Replacement Center

Our multidisciplinary team of medical professionals is at the forefront of performing minimally invasive surgeries such as:

- Gender-specific knee implants
- Hip resurfacing
- Complex revision surgery
- MIS2 (minimally invasive 2-incision total hip replacement)
- Ankle replacement (began in 2008)

Our state-of-the-art knee and hip replacement programs earned Disease-Specific Care Certification from the Joint Commission.

Institute for Patient Blood Management And Bloodless Medicine and Surgery

Englewood Hospital is world-renowned for the practice of bloodless medicine and surgery. Since its founding in 1994, our Institute for Patient Blood Management and Bloodless Medicine and Surgery has provided medical care to more than 35,000 patients from the U.S. and abroad. More than 200 physicians from every discipline have been trained and practice bloodless medicine and surgical techniques here.

The use of patient blood management techniques has been shown to correlate

to shorter hospital stays, faster healing and reduced risk of transfusion-associated infection and disease. A number of our physicians have trained their peers from organizations around the country and abroad, including Johns Hopkins and the Cleveland Clinic, in the practice of bloodless medicine and surgery.



Ninety-five percent of all elective surgery at the Medical Center is performed without blood transfusions or the use of blood products.

The state-of-the-art **Russell and Angelica Berrie Center for Humanistic Care**, which opened in 2004, houses our Ambulatory Surgery and Breast Care Centers. A bridge connecting the Berrie Center to the main hospital provides ready access to the Medical Center's surgical and acute-care facilities.



Radiology

The high caliber of our board-certified, Fellowship-trained Radiologists and registered Technologists distinguish Englewood Hospital's Department of Radiology from those at other hospitals and imaging centers. Recently earning reaccreditation in Ultrasound, CatScan and MRI from the American College of Radiology, the Radiology Department prides itself on using the best state-of-the-art equipment. It provides patients the highest level of expert care, a caring staff that understands and helps soothe their anxieties, and the shortest wait-time in the area. Our Radiologists participate in professional forums and other venues to remain at the forefront of medical advancements.

Family Birth Place

In addition to providing unsurpassed medical care, our comprehensive approach to obstetrics addresses the physical *and* emotional needs and concerns of the mother *and* other family members before, during and after the birth of a baby. Patients have access to a skilled team of professional Obstetricians, Anesthesiologists, Neonatologists, Perinatologists, Pediatricians, Pediatric Specialists and specially trained Nurses. Our Antepartum Testing Center, accredited by the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine, combines medical expertise with the latest technology to provide the greatest available accuracy in prenatal diagnosis of possible birth defects or other maternal or fetal problems. Our fully equipped NICU is rated the highest level for community hospitals. Our team of Board Certified Neonatologists and NICU nurses is available 24 hours a day to work with pediatricians in treating infants with acute illnesses.

The Wound Healing Center

Our Wound Healing Center has been helping patients heal chronic, non-healing ulcers for more than a decade. A cornerstone of this program is the Medical Center's Hyperbaric Center. Offering treatment for a wide range of disorders, our Hyperbaric Center is the only facility in northern New Jersey with a fully certified staff (NBDHMT) and the only hyperbaric oxygen (HBO) treatment center in New Jersey providing full service 24/7.

Ambulatory Surgery

Meeting the growing demand for outpatient services, our seven ambulatory surgery operating suites feature the most advanced technology for a range of minimally invasive procedures, including laparoscopic and laser surgery.

Physicians at Englewood Hospital and Medical Center have the support of the finest nurses. Our Medical Center is among the 4% of hospitals nationwide to earn Magnet status for excellence in nursing from the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC)—and we've received this distinction twice. Two-thirds of our staff nurses and care managers hold either a BSN or MSN in nursing, far exceeding the national average.



Multifaceted Physician Programs

- **Physician Relations Program.** This comprehensive program provides an effective way for physicians, their office managers and staff to communicate their needs to our physician liaisons, who help get needed changes implemented quickly and efficiently.
- **New Physician Orientation.** This program introduces doctors who are new to our Medical Center to hospital personnel and procedures so they can become integrated as smoothly and quickly as possible.
- **Dynamic Referral Service.** Our physician referral service receives more than 10,000 calls a year from area residents seeking a physician. In addition, a searchable database on the hospital's website allows visitors to do an online search for a physician who meets their criteria.
- **Active Speaker's Bureau.** Physicians at Englewood Hospital have numerous opportunities to address area residents on a range of issues through community forums such as the Rotary, Chamber of Commerce, local schools, and many other organizations.

Ongoing Expansion and Growth

Redefining the state of the art

Englewood Hospital and Medical Center has grown to become a regional leader in providing the latest advances in compassionate care in a humanistic environment. We've seen an average 15% - 20% increase in patient volumes in the last two years. During this time, we've added new staff members, welcomed 130 new physicians, and improved our financial performance.

A prime example of our recent growth is the construction of our new state-of-the-art Emergency Care Center, slated to open in the fall of 2009. Demand for our emergency services has increased from 25,000 visits a year in the 1970s to 42,000 visits in 2008.

Our new 35,000 sq. ft. Emergency Center will enable us to efficiently and effectively treat the growing numbers of patients who come to us for the best in Emergency Care. Featuring the latest technologies (including a dedicated imaging center), the Center is designed to promote staff efficiency and maximize comfort and privacy for patients and their families.



The 35,000-sq.-ft. Emergency Care Center, opening in fall 2009, will help us respond to a dramatic increase in patient volumes with new, state-of-the art facilities and technologies, including a dedicated imaging center.

Driving Directions

From Garden State Parkway South: South to exit 163. Take Route 17 South to Route 4 East exit. On Route 4 East, take second Grand Avenue exit (Grand Avenue/Englewood). At stop sign, make right. Grand Avenue becomes Engle Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is on the left.

From Palisades Interstate Parkway: Take Parkway South to exit 1 (Englewood). Exit onto Palisade Avenue and follow to Engle Street. Make right onto Engle Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is one mile ahead on the left.

From 9W North: 9W North to Palisade Avenue. Make left onto Palisade Avenue and follow to Engle Street. Make right on Engle Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is one mile ahead on the left.

From 9W South: 9W South to Palisade Avenue. Turn right on Palisade Avenue and follow to Engle Street. Make right on Engle Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is one mile ahead on the left.

From George Washington Bridge: Follow signs to Route 4 West. On Route 4 West, take first Grand Avenue exit (Grand Avenue/Englewood). Grand Avenue becomes Engle Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is ahead on the left.

From Route 17 South: Take Route 4 East exit. On Route 4, take second Grand Avenue exit (Grand Avenue/Englewood). Make right at stop sign. Grand Avenue becomes Engle Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is ahead on the left.

From Old Hook Road: Travel East on Old Hook Road (CR-502). Old Hook Road becomes High Street. Take High Street to Knickerbocker Road. Turn right onto Knickerbocker Road (CR-505). Pass through one roundabout. In Englewood, turn left onto Ivy Lane. Turn right onto Dean Street. Englewood Hospital and Medical Center is ahead on the left.
